Dear Parents:

We are excited to be welcoming your child into kindergarten for the 2017-2018 school year. In preparation for your child's enrollment, the following items must be completed and brought with you to kindergarten screening:

1. The Ohio School Health History
2. An Original or Certified Birth Certificate
3. A copy of an up-to-date immunization record or letter of exempt

**Current Ohio immunization requirements for Kindergarten admittance include:**

- 5 doses of Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (DTaP)
- 4 doses of Polio
- 3 doses of Hepatitis B
- 2 doses of Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
- 2 doses of Varicella (chickenpox)

If your child's immunizations are not up-to-date, you will need to contact the health department or your primary care physician as soon as possible to obtain the missing requirements. The Seneca County Health Department may be reached at 419-447-3691 or 1-800-698-3691.

Please contact me if you have any further questions regarding the documents needed for kindergarten screening or if you have any medical concerns for your student's upcoming school year.
