About the Foundation:

The Charles D. "Bud" Hering, Jr. Foundation is a permanent charitable and educational trust established to honor and commemorate the life and career of the late Tiffin attorney. In recognition of Mr. Hering's long and loyal service to his clients, his many friends and his personal commitment to the community in which he lived, his clients and friends have created this Foundation as a lasting memorial.

The primary purposes of the Hering Foundation are:

- To provide funds for educational opportunities to the Tiffin area youth, and to extend financial aid to qualified charitable organizations whose stated goal is to improve social and economic conditions in the Tiffin area. Since 1993, the Foundation has awarded over \$281,000.00 to fifty-three (53) graduating seniors from Seneca County High Schools. A portion of the financial assistance has been awarded to past recipients to insure their successful completion of college.

Educational scholarship eligibility:

- In order for a senior to be eligible for the Hering Memorial Foundation Scholarship, he or she must graduate from Tiffin Columbian, Tiffin Calvert, or a Seneca County High School, be a resident of *Seneca* County, and be enrolled or accepted in an accredited *Ohio* college or university.
- The student must complete the application form provided. ***Scholarships are awarded based on financial need and academic achievement.***
- Further, the student must be a person who represents in character the same devotion to family, school, and community that Charles D. Hering, Jr. exemplified in his life.

Role of the Guidance Counselor:

The Board of Trustees of the Foundation request that the Guidance Counselor assist them in communication and application screening.

- Application forms will be provided to each school for the Guidance Counselor to distribute to graduating seniors who will be attending an *Ohio* accredited college whom he or she feels is qualified under the guidelines of the Foundation.
- Once the applications are returned to the Counselor, a predetermined number of finalists should be forwarded to the Secretary of the Board of Trustees for final screening and recipient awarding.
